Term 1 Around the World

English:

We will be focusing on sentence writing this half term. We are starting with the story Handa's Hen. These are the skills that we will be working on.

- Using Capital letters to start a sentence.
- Using full stops to end sentences.
- Using spaces between words.
- Adding simple adjectives to describe.
- Writing in sentences and reading them back.

We are going to be reading:

Handa's Hen by Eileen Brown

Crocodile Bridge – Traditional Japanese story.

A separate sheet will be sent home with common exception words to practise reading and writing ready for spelling tests in Autumn 2.

Useful words

We are going to be focusing on numbers within 100! We will start by counting, reading and writing numbers to 10 and 20 initially, before moving on to addition and subtraction.

- Write numbers in order.
- Count everything!
- Add and subtract numbers.
