



Forest School Sessions

Forest School is a specialised outdoor learning approach with a focus on developing children's confidence and self-esteem by providing opportunities for hands-on learning in our school woodland environment at Boothville.

All Year 3 children will have the fantastic opportunity to take part in Forest School sessions throughout the seasons of the year. Each class will have 2 afternoon sessions per term (Autumn I, Spring I, Summer I).

Year 3 Dates for Forest School Session in Autumn 1

3BG — Thursday 14th and Tuesday 19th September 2023

3BL — Tuesday 26th and Tuesday 3rd October 2023

3MG — Tuesday 10th and Tuesday 17th October 2023

All children will need to come to school on their Forest School day in their school uniform with additional clothing in a separate bag. Your child will need the following clothes to change into:

- · Old trousers & long-sleeved top to protect skin from potential hazards such as nettle stings
- Old trainers/shoes that you don't mind getting wet & muddy
- A separate bag so mucky clothes can be taken home
- Sunhat/sun cream if weather is hot
- Raincoat/Waterproof trousers/wellies if weather is wet

* Please check the weather forecast ahead of the session just to be sure of the appropriate clothing that will be required.
