Double cod fish finger or fish star or veggie nuggets with chips

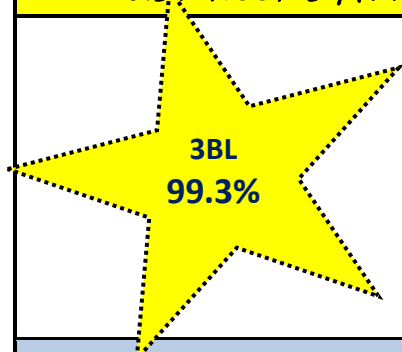
Reception, Year 1 and 2 are eligible for a hot meal at lunch time with no payment needed.
