Our Year 6 children were fantastic last week. The children at Longtown excelled in all of the challenges and the children who ran the Enterprise Project worked extremely hard. Well done!

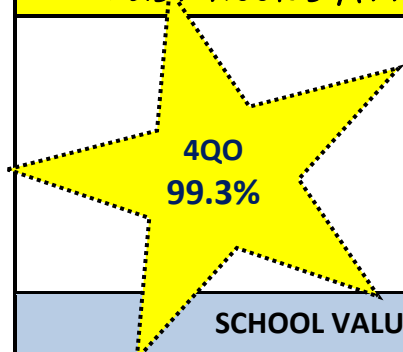
