Please remember that school is closed next Friday for a Training Day.

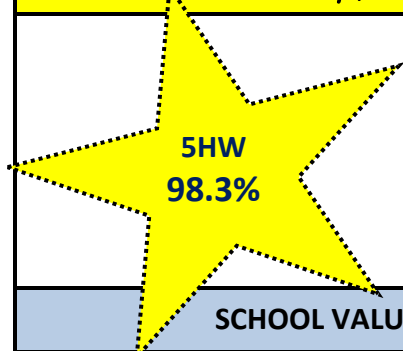
